Progress

Thank you to all who have registered for our AOA 2009

To those who intend Registering and not done so, (or if you know of anyone who is interested and has not registered) please do not delay any longer, as we have had to make our CLOSING DATE for entries on NOVEMBER 30th., 2008.

Clarification

Our reference to Comprehensive Motor Vehicle Insurance has created some confusion to some, so if this has deterred anyone please be assured Third Party Property Insurance is OK.

Also there is no need to supply insurance papers to us, but we recommend you have them with you when you travel.

Regalia

Firstly, an apology. The cloth badge dimensions are 90mm x 65mm (not 110 x 80).

Secondly, sorry if we confused you, we printed the Polo Shirt measurement chart as it was supplied to us, not realising that our regalia supplier was using the new standard (we are told) for sizing that the manufacturers are now using. Please advise us if you need to alter your size/s.

The measurement obtained is by placing a shirt on a flat surface and measuring the width approximately 25mm below the join of the sleeve to the shirt body

For those who have ordered, or intend ordering bottles of AOA 2009 Port, you are paying for the collectible bottles and AOA 2009 labels, with the contents coming to you free.

Closing date for regalia also is NOVEMBER 30th. Orders after that date may be able to be filled and we plan to have some regalia for purchase at the Registration, but please do not assume what you want will be available. IF we are able to take orders at the AOA we would have to charge postage to the purchasers.

Don't forget – MINIMUMS apply, and some items may not be available due to insufficient orders.

Food
